## BRIEF HISTORY OF JANATA COLLEGE

Janata College was set up in 1964 by a galaxy of dedicated individual philanthropists and academicians with a pious vision to disseminate higher education in these remote parts of the country. Unlike other rural colleges of this valley, Janata College has its own identity and fame as an institution of higher education. The college has gloriously completed 60 years. The college is situated at Kabuganj at a distance of 20 Km away from South-East Silchar in the District of Cachar, Assam. From the time when it was established, the institution has been striving relentlessly to enlighten the rural populace through higher education in an area predominantly inhabited by those belonging to SC, ST (H), ST (P), Tea Garden Labourers, OBC and MOBC. It is the only co-educational institute in the valley with a pretty large enrolment of girls. During the last four decades, it is the only college which has contributed immensely towards educational development of the needy and marginalized sections of people. Initially the College did not have its own building. On the 8<sup>th</sup> of April 1964, it started its journey with a limited number of students of Pre-University classes at L.C. High School, Kabuganj in the morning shift. The foundation stone was laid in the same year. The College has altogether 23 bighas of land out of which 18 bighas are in one plot. The college was initially affiliated to Gauhati University (till 1993) and later came under the jurisdiction of Assam University in 1994. The College was taken over by the Government of Assam under the Deficit System of Grants-in-Aids on 1st December 1975 and brought under Provincialized system on 1st December, 2005. This College also received recognition from the UGC, Delhi under 2(F) and 12 (B) of UGC Rule.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### A. ADMISSION FOR H.S & FYUG

- i. Application for admission into the College should be made through the prescribed online portal Samarth (FYUG) and Darpan (HS). Admission to the FYUG course will be through CUET (UG) only.
- ii. Notices prescribing the norms, date of counselling, admission etc. will be posted in the College website and in the College Notice Board.
- iii. Admission process is conducted under direct control of Admission Committee constituted for the purpose. There is an admission committee headed by a Convener. The committee will determine the respective admission criteria for all the departments.
- iv. The candidates have to submit separate admission forms for separate faculties.
- v. While filling up the forms for admission, an applicant should pay due attention in the matter of furnishing his/her preference for combination he/she intends to study.
- vi. Admission is based strictly on merit and is governed by college admission rules framed by admission committees. Convener's decision regarding admission stands final.
- vii. Any undue pressure or interference in matter(s) of admission will be treated as disqualification amounting to forfeiture of claim for admission.
- viii. The attested copies of the following documents are to be furnished along with application for admission:

- **Supporting documents to prove domicile of Assam**
- Mark Sheet and Certificates of HS.L.C. and other qualifying examinations.
- Character Certificate.
- SC/ST/OBC/MOBC Certificate.
- Gap certificate in case the student passed the qualifying examination earlier than the current year.
- Migration certificate for C.B.S.E. and outside State students.
- One Latest Passport size photograph for Identity card and
- Income certificate from competent authority for students seeking admission under fee waiver scheme

**Note: No request for admission will be entertained after the prescribed date fixed by the authority.**

### B. SOME IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- i. Submission of Registration form for H.S. & FYUP students is compulsory.
- ii. Students are directed to go through the Notice Board/College Website regularly to acquire necessary information from time to time.
- iii. Guardians are requested to keep checking the local newspaper and college website for Eligibility criteria, date of admission in Higher secondary & FYUP Courses.

### C. CHANGE OF SUBJECT(s)/COMBINATION

In general, change of subject(s)/combination is not encouraged. Students should give proper thought in the matter before filling in their application form for admission which will be counselled by respective departmental teachers.

### D. COLLEGE TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

Application for Transfer Certificate shall be accompanied by the following requisites:

- i) Dues clearance certificate from the College Office.
- ii) Library Clearance Certificate
- iii) Hostel Clearance Certificate
- iv) Records of attendance duly signed by the respective Heads of the Departments,
- v) Surrender of College Identity Card

### E. ADMISSION OF UNSUCCESSFUL STUDENTS

- i. H.S. 1st Year and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year students who appeared at the AHSE Council's examination but failed, shall appear at the subsequent First Year/Final Year Examination of the Council as non-collegiate candidates.
- ii. In case of TDC and FYUG Students, guidelines of Assam University will be applicable.

### F. COLLEGE EXAMINATION AND ATTENDANCE RULES

- i. Minimum 2 (two) Unit Tests will be held in FYUG & H.S. Level. Weightage will be given to examination results of Unit Tests in sending up students for Council/University Examination.
- ii. **A minimum of 75% of class attendance is mandatory to appear in the Council/University examination, as a regular candidate.**

### G. GENERAL RULES FOR DISCIPLINE

- i. The college maintains a high standard of discipline. Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building of students. They are to obey traditional norms of discipline.
- ii. Students and guardians are required to furnish an undertaking at the time of admission in respect of the students' conduct in the college campus, regular attendance in classes and appearance in college examinations.
- iii. The students admitted to the college must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of college and hostel fees, showing discourtesy to the teachers and staff members in any form, adoption of unfair means in the examination etc. are some of the offences which may make the erring students liable for disciplinary action like termination of scholarship, non-award of college certificate, forced transfer, expulsion from the College and Hostel.

- iv. Students are to keep Photo-Identity Cards with them in the College campus. On demand, students are required to produce Photo-Identity Cards issued to them by the college authority. Failure to produce the Identity Cards may debar them from attending Classes/ College.
- v. Students may be suspended / expelled / device seized or refused admission to next session for any breach of college or hostel discipline, such as
  - Use of alcoholic beverages and hallucinatory drugs.
  - Political or communal involvement which affect the peace and harmony in the College Campus.
- vi. Use of Mobile Phone & Cell phone, iPod, MP3 players by the students within the College Campus is strictly prohibited.
- vii. Parking place should be used for parking of two-wheelers, cycles, cars etc.
- viii. While within the College Campus, students should be in college uniform with college emblem.
- ix. All forms of ragging in hostel and college-campus are strictly prohibited and will make a student liable to punitive/disciplinary action.
- x. The courses of studies in Janata College are full time courses. No student can take any other full-time courses/job anywhere simultaneously.
- xi. Students' Society and Associations shall be subjected to such rules and regulations that college administration may describe from time to time.
- xii. Unit Tests and Class Tests are mandatory for all. Student attendance is generally displayed on the notice board before Puja vacation (September/ October) for form fill up. Results of all college examinations including test examination are published within 7 days from the last examination. Students and guardians are requested to go through the notice board regularly.
- xiii. All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the Head of the Institution and his decision shall be final in all such matters.
- xiv. In case of emergency a student can meet the Principal (from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.) Group entry inside the Principal's chamber is strictly prohibited.

## INSTRUCTION FOR FOUR YEARS UNDER GRADUATE (FYUG) PROGRAMME (under NEP 2020)

### **Primary Guidelines for implementation of NEP 2020 for UG courses of colleges affiliated to Assam University, Silchar**

**In order to implement NEP 2020 from the session 2023-24 for UG courses in affiliated colleges following primary guidelines will be followed**

1. UG curriculum for colleges affiliated to Assam University shall be a four-year UG programme (FYUG) as per curriculum structure provided in Annexure-1. Option for lateral exit shall be free from additional 04 credit earning. In lieu of Project/ Dissertation in VIII semester, students shall have option to take three additional courses as Discipline Specific Course which will be equal to 12 credits in total. However, students opting for project/dissertation will be given Honours with Research degree and students opting for additional three Discipline Specific courses in lieu of Project/Dissertation will be given Honours degree. It is also resolved that all those three papers (DSC-452,453 and 454) should be of level 500. FYUG is structured with options for lateral Exit and Entry at various levels:

**Certificate, Diploma, Bachelor's Degree or Bachelor's Degree with Honours to be provided at the end of each year of exit under FYUG**

	Exit Options
1.	<b>Certificate:</b> Upon the Successful Completion of the 1 <sup>st</sup> Year (2 Semester)
2.	<b>Diploma:</b> Upon the Successful Completion of the 2nd Year (4 Semester)
3.	<b>Bachelor's Degree:</b> Upon the Successful Completion of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Year (6 Semester)
4.	<b>Bachelor's Degree with Honors and/or Research:</b> In a discipline / subject, upon the Successful Completion of the 4 <sup>th</sup> Year (8 Semester)

2. Offering Four Year Under Graduate (FYUG) programme is mandatory for all affiliated colleges. However, the colleges Departments shall have liberty if Honours with Research be offered or not depending upon their infrastructural limitation.

***FYUG comprises the following Courses:***

**DSC** – Discipline Specific Core

**DSM** - Discipline Specific Minor

(For each subject, DSM is of two kinds, viz., First Minor & Second Minor)

**IDC** – Inter Disciplinary Course

**AEC** – Ability Enhancement Course [Alternative English or MIL (Languages)]

**SEC** – Skill Enhancement Course

**VAC** – Value Added Course

3. Interdisciplinary courses shall have 04 baskets viz: Natural Sciences (NS), Social Sciences (SS), Humanities (HN) and Commerce & Management (CM). Students may opt for any one from those 04 baskets in each of I, II and III semesters.

Bunching of subjects in each basket shall be as per Annexure-II.

4. From Discipline Specific Minor students shall take two subjects related to his/her Discipline. Each such subject should be 50% of total credit allotted to this course Viz: for Three Year UG programme each Discipline Specific Minor shall be of 13 credits and for Four Year UG programme each Discipline Specific Minor shall be of 17 credits. Assam University shall notify cluster of subjects from which Discipline Specific Minor (DSM) can be chosen. To be more precise it is decided that DSM- 101(3). DSM-201 (4). DSM -251(3) and DSM-301(3) = 13 credits should be the first minor  
  
subjects in case of Three Year UG Programme (TYUG) and DSM-151 (3) DSM -252 (3). DSM-DSM-302 (3) and DSM-351(4)-13 should be second minor subject. For FYUG Programme DSM 401 (4) should be first minor subject and DSM -451(4) should be second minor subject.
5. Students securing highest CGPA (above 6.0) and with no back paper shall be allowed to change his/ her core course once only after completion of second semester However, if a candidate desires to make one of his/her minors to core then automatic change in the minor should be done as same subject cannot be opted as both core and minor. Also change of core may be allowed only within allied subjects.
6. **7.5 CGPA should be obtained by a student up to 3<sup>rd</sup> year for opting Honours with Research Degree in 4 years. However, for only Honours degree there shall not be any CGPA restriction. But students with arrear paper shall not be allowed to move to 4<sup>th</sup> year in any case.**
7. Evaluation of 3 and 4 credit courses shall be out of 100 marks and that for 2 credit courses shall be out of 50 marks
8. IDC courses opted shall remain same for all three semesters. Semester wise change of IDC is not allowed.
9. For AEC courses, there shall not be any internal exam. Total Marks for AEC examination shall be 50 with two hours examination duration. In 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sem there is compulsory English language paper (EL) for all students under AEC.
10. SEC shall have to be opted from either DSC or DSM. Evaluation method for SEC for Science stream shall be 50 (End Semester Theory) +30 (End Sem Practical/Project/Field work) + 20 (internal test of which 14 for test and 6 for attendance). The same pattern is followed for Arts and commerce.
11. For EVS (VAC-151) evaluation method shall be 70 (End Semester exam) + 30 Internal Assignment. Marks for Internal test shall again be divided to 20 for written test and 10 for attendance.
- 12 Evaluation method for VAC-101 (with practical) shall be same as that of SEC (with practical) and that of VAC-101 (Without practical) shall be same as VAC-151.

13. EVS in VAC-151 should be of 100 level and EVS included in Natural Science Basket as IDC should be of 200 level.
14. Publication/Presentation of papers out of Research Project/ Dissertation carried out in VIII semester is not mandatory. However, the project shall have to be presented before Departmental Research Committee and in presence of an external examiner during end semester examination. Total marks for the project shall be 300 of which 90 shall be internal and 210 is for end semester examination. In case of Dissertation Project, out of 90 marks as internal, there shall be three progress reviews and each review shall be of 30 marks. Marks obtained by a student in each of the review shall be notified immediately. Review of progress shall be done by concerned supervisor in presence of Departmental Research Committee.
15. For all other courses evaluation method shall be of 70 marks (for End Semester Examination) and 30 marks (for Internal Examination), Marks for Internal test shall again be divided to 20 for written test and 10 for attendance.
16. For VAC 151 (EVS), shall not have any practical component.
17. **For opting DSC and DSM combination, clustering of subjects shall be as per ANNEXURE-III. DSC from one cluster and DSM from other cluster is not allowed. DSC, DSM and IDC cannot be the same subject.**
18. All DSM courses shall be stand-alone and students can select first minor subject and second minor subject according to their choice keeping total requirement of 17 credit for each minor but they cannot change the code of minor papers, viz: One student of Physics (Core) may have Chemistry as first minor in DSM 101 and Mathematics as second minor in DSM 151. But the other student of Physics (core) may have Mathematics as first minor in DSM-101 and Chemistry as second minor in DSM 151.
19. For *Research with Honours* students. DSC-451 paper shall be research methodology and content of this course shall be same across the subjects and across the disciplines. However, for other students. DSC 451 will be a usual 500 level paper.
20. **Any student interested to opt for Honours with Research should have 7.5 CGPA upto third year without any arrear.**
21. In lieu of MIL, Alternative English may be opted by a student
