SPOT ADMISSION GUIDELINES 2026

Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP), Academic Session 2026-27

1. Date, Time and Venue

Date of Spot Admission	15th June, 2026 (Monday)
Reporting Time	9:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon
Publication of Merit List & Admission of Candidates	On 15th June, 2026, after 12:00 Noon
Venue	Auditorium, Janata College, Kabuganj

2. Who May Participate in the Spot Admission Round

The following categories of candidates are eligible to participate, as per the SAMARTH Guidelines for Spot Admissions:

1. Candidates who have not secured admission in the earlier merit rounds conducted through the Portal.
2. Candidates who have not yet registered on the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>). Such candidates must complete fresh registration on the Portal before applying for Spot Admission.
3. Candidates who wish to cancel their admission already secured in an earlier round in another institution and seek admission in Janata College, Kabuganj, subject to vacancy of seats and the provisions of this policy.

Candidates already registered on the Portal need not register again. Mere reporting at the College or registration on the Portal does not confer any right to admission.

3. Preparation of Merit List on 15th June, 2026

1. All candidates reporting at the College from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon on 15th June, 2026 shall be registered at the Admission Help Desk and issued a serial token upon preliminary verification of documents and of the application submitted on the Portal.
2. A programme wise and discipline wise Merit List shall be prepared on the same day on the basis of marks obtained in the Higher Secondary (Class XII) of all candidates so registered up to 12:00 Noon.
3. The Merit List shall be published on the College notice board on 15th June, 2026 after 12:00 Noon, and admission shall be offered strictly in order of merit, subject to seat vacancy, applicable reservation, quota provisions, and verification of original documents.
4. Cut off marks for each discipline shall be declared on the spot, depending upon the number of available seats and the merit of candidates present.

4. Admission of Candidates Reporting After 12:00 Noon

1. Candidates reporting after 12:00 Noon on 15th June, 2026 shall not be included in the Merit List.
2. Such candidates shall be considered for admission strictly on a first come first serve basis, in the order of their physical reporting and token serial at the Admission Help Desk, subject to vacancy of seats remaining after admission of merit listed candidates, fulfilment of eligibility criteria, and verification of documents.
3. The Spot Admission process for a particular programme or discipline shall come to a halt as soon as all vacant seats therein are filled. Reporting at the College on the scheduled date and time does not, by itself, guarantee admission.

5. Reservation of Seats

5.1 Statutory Reservation:

Reservation of seats for SC, ST(P), ST(H), OBC/MOBC, EWS and PwD candidates shall be applicable as per the prevailing norms of the Government of Assam.

Reserved category seats remaining unfilled for want of eligible candidates of the respective category shall be dealt with as per Government norms and, where permissible, shall revert to the open pool of the Spot Round.

5.2 Institutional Quota for Janata College HS Passed Out Students (20%):

1. **20% (twenty percent) of the vacant seats in each programme available for the Spot Admission Round shall stand reserved for candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (Class XII) examination from Janata College, Kabuganj.**
2. A separate Merit List of such candidates reporting up to 12:00 Noon on 15th June, 2026 shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Higher Secondary examination, and seats under this quota shall be filled in order of merit therefrom.
3. Claim under this quota must be supported by the Higher Secondary marksheet, certificate or admit card issued in respect of Janata College, Kabuganj, along with the College HS registration particulars.
4. Seats under this quota remaining unfilled after exhaustion of eligible own HS candidates shall automatically revert to the general pool of the Spot Round on the same day.

6. Scrutiny and Grant of Admission

1. The College shall adhere to the established procedures of academic scrutiny on the Portal. Admission shall be granted only after the application is thoroughly reviewed and marked as Accepted at both the Academic Scrutiny and the Final Scrutiny levels.
2. No merit list shall be processed on the Portal for the Spot Round; admissions shall be processed on the Portal in the same manner as in the previous rounds, subject to seat availability, on the basis of the institutional Merit List and first come first serve mechanism notified herein.
3. Any admission found to have been secured on the basis of false, fabricated or suppressed information shall be liable to cancellation at any stage, apart from such other action as deemed fit.
